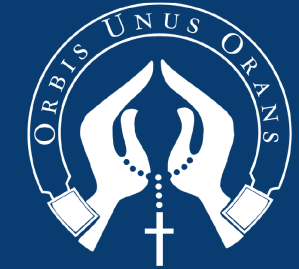

The apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima in 1917 inspired millions of people to take up their rosaries and offer acts of penance in reparation for sins and to console their God who was greatly offended. The spread of Our Lady's message and response from the faithful brought

about an end to a world at war, and helped fight against the "red army" of atheistic communism—spiritual battles which continue today.

To celebrate the 100th Anniversary of this important call from our Heavenly Mother, the World Apostolate of Fatima, USA is launching a two-year U.S. Tour for Peace with the world-famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima. The tour will visit at least 100 dioceses in all 50 states, beginning March 21, 2016 (100th anniversary of the Angel of Peace apparitions) and continue through December 2017.



The tour is dedicated to the three shepherd children, Blessed Francisco, Blessed Jacinta and Sister Lucia.

GOALS OF THE TOUR

- Bring the graces of Fatima to the American people and help a new generation learn, live and spread the Message of Fatima—heaven's "peace plan" for these times
- Ignite hope and confidence in the Blessed Mother, who loves and desires the salvation of souls
- Inspire people of all ages to respond to the urgent call for the daily rosary, penance, and the practice of the First Saturday Communions of Reparation
- Promote Marian Consecration and the Divine Mercy devotion, intimately linked with the Fatima Message

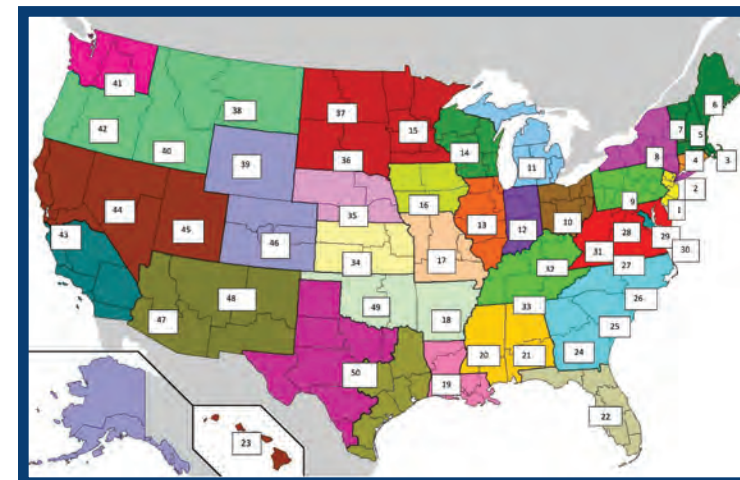

The World-Famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima

This remarkable statue was sculpted by famous sculptor José Thedim, based on the description of Sister Lucia. On October 13, 1947, the image was blessed by the Bishop of Liera at Fatima and commissioned to serve as the Pilgrim

Virgin who would carry the blessings of Fatima throughout the world.

It was first brought to the United States by John Haffert, co-founder of The Blue Army, who had composed the Blue Army pledge with Sister Lucia and helped spread the Message of Fatima worldwide.

The Pilgrim Virgin traveled throughout Europe and arrived in Fatima in 1951 at the close of the Holy Year designated by Pope Pius XII. During his radio address to over a million people gathered for the occasion, His Holiness remarked, "In 1946, I crowned Our Lady of Fatima as Queen of the World and the following year, through the Pilgrim Virgin, She set forth as though to claim Her dominion, and the favors She performs along the way are such that we can hardly believe what we are seeing with our eyes."

Pope Pius XII blessed the statue on October 24, 1952, and imparted a special blessing on the work of the Pilgrim Virgin peace tours. One of the most famous peace tours occurred on October 16, 1992 when six bishops descended on Red Square in Moscow carrying the Pilgrim Virgin Statue. It was crowned at midnight in front of Lenin's tomb.

The statue has visited more than 100 countries bringing the great message of salvation and hope, "the peace plan from Heaven," to countless millions of people. Many miracles and signal graces have been reported wherever the statue has traveled.

On September 1, 2014, the custody and mission of the statue was placed under the auspice of The World Apostolate of Fatima, USA and continues her journeys with our custodian Patrick Sabat.
