FEES

Registration fees for local parishes that DO NOT REQUIRE hotel accommodation \$ 120

Registration fees for parishes that NEED hotel accommodation \$ 200

Everyone, including adults and God Squad, must be registered and pay the registration fee.

Fees are non-refundable.

There is limited financial aid available again this year to Idaho parishes. See page 33.

CHAPERONES

Each group will need one adult (21+ years or older) for every seven (7) youth attending by gender (one adult woman for every 7 female youth, etc.) with a minimum requirement of 2 chaperones per gender. Every adult in Idaho must attend the Diocese of Boise's "Creating a Safe Environment," an in person, face-to-face training, initially and renew their Safe Environment Training online annually with CMG Connect. Every adult must also successfully clear a criminal background check and renew every 5 years. Contact your parish site admin coordinator for verification of Safe Environment and background check status of your chaperones.

Safe Environment should be sent to Veronica Childers (208) 350-7556 phone, (208) 489-7475 fax no later than Friday, February 16, 2024. Background check should be sent to Gina Burns (208) 350-7553 phone, (208) 489-7475 Fax no later than Friday, February 16, 2024. Only chaperones who complete the workshop and successfully pass the background check will be allowed to attend ICYC with their parish group. There will be no exceptions.

Chaperones are responsible for monitoring their youth throughout the ENTIRE event including at night in the hotels. Chaperones MUST accompany their youth to the nurse and MUST carry a copy of all of their youth medical forms at all times.

No ICYC attendees--youth or adults--can leave the venue during the event.

BUS TRANSPORTATION BETWEEN FORD IDAHO CENTER SPORTS CENTER and HOTELS



Once you receive your different links you will need to register through the Chaperone Link.
2. All fields marked with a *** asterisk** are required fields.
3. Take special care to write your email address correctly. This will be your “**USERNAME**” to access the new Registration Platform for ICYC.
4. Name of your Parish. If several chapels and/or stations are traveling with a parish, ONLY USE THE NAME OF THE PARISH.

6. On this screen you will find the following question: *Will you require “Local” event?*
 - Bus transportation will be available between the Ford Idaho Center Sports Arena and the hotels at \$50 per person. *This option is used by many local parishes when parents transport their youth to/from the event.*
Groups cannot be split between bus and private transportation.
IMPORTANT: Please note that all teens and adult chaperones attending ICYC will be transported from their hotel on their assigned bus to and from the venue. Your group numbers for the bus must match the number of people in your group
- . 7. The last field that you must answer is the number of participants in your group. This number includes: Youth Minister, Adult Chaperones & Youth.
 - We have noticed that although you can add more spots later, when you do this it creates another invoice for the added spots. Please add as many spots as you think or hope you will need. It is okay if you add more than you need.
Once the registration closes, we will delete the spots that have not been used so that your parish is billed accordingly.




- Your name will be displayed, followed by the number of people you created in your group, the date of the event, and the amount of your group's registration fees. Registration fees will be updated for each new registration.



Payments

MEALS

-- There are no concession stands in the Sports Arena. Please make sure your group has eaten before arriving Friday. Breakfast at your hotel. Saturday's lunch and dinner are included. There may be food trucks before the event on Friday night.--

ICYC 2024 T-SHIRTS

ICYC t-shirts are included in the registration price this year.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

We will be using 14 hotels this year. Boys and girls from the same parish will be staying in different hotels. Rooms for four people will have two double/queen beds. Rooms for two people may have a single queen bed. There will be a maximum of 4 people per room. (*Per Safe Environment requirements adults and youth must be in separate rooms unless they are parent and child. A single youth cannot be assigned to a room alone.*)

The diocese aims to make the attendance of ICYC as simple as possible for our Youth Ministry leaders and therefore we have pre-negotiated rates at hotels in the Treasure Valley. In order to fit as many groups comfortably as we can the diocese will assign each Parish group a hotel. Some of the hotels will provide room numbers but others may not, if a hotel provides room numbers Memo will email those numbers to you when he emails your hotel assignment.

It is the Parishes' responsibility to assign ICYC participants to rooms and make sure that each room assignment fulfills safe environment standards. When a minor leaves the Sports Center with a Chaperone the Parish assumes all responsibility for this minor until they return to the Sports Center for the remaining part of ICYC.

If you need to be housed in the same hotel as another parish you MUST let Memo know via email (MGuiterrez@RCDB.org) prior to the close of registration, midnight Mountain Time on February 09.

Adults can request a semi-private room (2 people/2beds) for an additional \$80 or a private room for an additional \$240. Requests for a private or semi-private room MUST be indicated on the online registration. These requests will be filled when possible. Youth do not have the semi-private/private option.

Please encourage your youth to bring sleeping bags if they have any concerns about sharing a bed with another youth.

After registration has closed, Memo will email your group's hotel and any relevant information for your accommodations to you. After assigning each person in your group a room, you will email that information to the hotel. At the point of Memo emailing you the assignment it is the Parishes' responsibility to communicate with the hotel by February 16. Whatever charges are incurred in excess due to the actions of your group will be passed on to the Parish via the invoice for ICYC.

Hotel security-Please make sure that your adult chaperones are aware of their responsibility to chaperone youth during their stay in the hotel as well as onsite at the Ford Idaho Center Sport Center. We will be hosting a webinar to discuss best practices and minimum requirements for hotels.

DRIVERS: TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES and DRIVER INFORMATION

The Transportation Guidelines and Driver Information forms must be filled out for all private vehicles being used. A copy of the Driver Information form should also be kept by the parish youth leader. Drivers must carry copies of youth medical/permission forms for each youth being transported in their vehicle.

11-15 passenger vans are NOT allowed.

If you are chartering a bus to/from ICYC, the bus company needs to provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance naming the parish and Diocese of Boise as additionally insured in the amount of \$1,000,000. If you or the bus company have questions, please contact Charles Lawrence at (208) 342-1311 or Clarence@RCDB.org. Several parishes may want to share a bus to reduce costs.

I. ALL DRIVERS

- A. Drivers must be 21 years of age or older.
- B. Drivers must have a valid, non-probationary driver's license and no physical disability that would impair his/her ability to drive the vehicle safely.
- C. Drivers must possess a current, valid driver's license for the type of vehicle that they will be operating.
- D. No driver will be hired or allowed to provide volunteer transportation on behalf of any diocesan entity who has had any of the following citations or convictions in the past three years:
 - 1. Operating a vehicle during a period of license suspension, revocation or forfeiture
 - 2. Driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs
 - 3. Hit and run accident
 - 4. Failure to report an accident
 - 5. Negligent homicide arising out of the use of a motor vehicle
 - 6. Using a motor vehicle for the commission of a felony
 - 7. Operating a motor vehicle without the owner's authority
 - 8. Permitting an unlicensed person to drive
 - 9. Reckless driving
- 10. A combined total of three or more accidents and/or moving violations
- E. It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure that passengers adhere to the current State of Idaho safety belt laws and regulations.
- F. Cell phones and other handheld electronic devices are not permitted to be used while driving a motor vehicle.

II. DRIVERS OF PRIVATE VEHICLES

- A. Anyone driving a personal vehicle must complete the Private Vehicle Driver Form and the Private Vehicle Use Application.
- B. Potential drivers are not permitted to drive if they answered "FALSE" to any of the three questions asked on the Volunteer Driver Form.

III. USE OF 11 (including driver) to 15 PASSENGER VANS

- A. The use of 11 (including driver) to 15 passenger vans is strictly prohibited.

IV. USE OF PRIVATE VEHICLES

- A. All privately owned vehicles used on behalf of the Church, must be insured. They must have a valid and current registration, license plates and proof of insurance card.
- B. The vehicle must be in safe operating condition.
- C. The private automobile insurance company of the owner of the vehicle will be the primary insurance carrier.
- D. The minimum liability limits for privately owned vehicles is \$100,000 (Single Injury)/\$300,000 (Per Accident) or \$300,000 CSL (Combined Single Liability).
- E. A Private Vehicle Use Application must be completed for each vehicle.

YOUTH CODE OF CONDUCT

In order to assure the safe and successful participation of young people and adults at gatherings sponsored by agencies and organizations of the Diocese of Boise, the following norms of behavior are to be followed. We expect you to represent your parish, school and the Diocese of Boise well during all gatherings! We hope that you will display

the mature, responsible leadership and character that has for so many years been the trademark of Catholic Youth Ministry within this Diocese.

SOME NORMS FOR PARTICIPATION...

1. Individuals are *responsible for their own actions* and will be asked to assume the consequences for their inappropriate behavior.
2. Participants are expected to take direction from those adult leaders who have been placed in positions of authority by the parish. Model positive behavior by being on time and respectful of event.
3. Purchase and/or use of tobacco products by minors is illegal. In observation of both the law and good health practices, smoking or chewing tobacco by participants is not allowed.
4. The purchase, possession, or consumption of BEER, WINE, or OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES by minors will not be tolerated. An infraction of this rule will mean immediate dismissal from the event.
5. The possession or use of ILLEGAL DRUGS by any individual will not be tolerated. Infraction of this rule will mean immediate dismissal from any event and appropriate action will be taken.
6. For the protection and safety of all participants, acts of violence or harassment will not be tolerated. Violence and harassment include fighting, physical or verbal assault or abuse, ethnic insults, profane or obscene language, gestures, or actions.
7. Possession of any weapon is strictly prohibited. Anyone who brings a weapon to an event or gathering will be asked to surrender the weapon to leaders and appropriate action will be taken.
8. Disruptive behavior, language, clothing, or items will not be acceptable at youth events. This includes any of the above, which is obscene, profane, or inappropriate to the activity of the church or group.
9. It is illegal for minors to take part in any organized form of gambling, and therefore such activity is strictly prohibited. Any other gambling activity is also strongly discouraged.
10. In the unlikely event that a behavior problem based on the above requires extreme action; it is likely to result in dismissal from the activity. Parents will be contacted and participants will be sent home, at the parent's expense.

PLEASE NOTE: *The Diocese does not insure personal property against theft or loss so please exercise caution regarding your own personal property.*

You are expected to observe the above guidelines in light of Idaho State statutes and definitions, even though the events may take place in another state or country. (EXAMPLE: The legal drinking age in Idaho is 21. This age will be the norm followed, even when in a place where the legal drinking age is lower.)

We respectfully ask for your cooperation and hope that you will have no trouble adhering by this simple code of behavior. The major thing to remember is that you represent the Church and are asked to project an image of Christian consideration, sensitivity and respect to others and to the property around you.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ADULT LEADERS

In order to ensure the safe and successful participation of young people and adults at gatherings sponsored by agencies and organizations of the Diocese of Boise, the following norms of behavior are to be followed. As an adult leader at this event, we expect you to provide leadership for your parish/school and the Diocese of Boise during all gatherings! We hope that you will display, support, defend, and encourage the mature, responsible leadership to, by, for, and with youth which has for so many years been the trademark of Catholic Youth Ministry within this Diocese.

SOME NORMS FOR PARTICIPATION FOR ADULT LEADERS...

1. Individual leaders are responsible for their own actions and also to some degree the actions of those young people they are with, and will be asked to assume the natural consequences for any negative behavior.
2. Adult leaders attending events must be screened for the protection of youth participants prior to being confirmed as a leader or chaperone for a parish-sponsored event, trip, outing, activity, etc. This screening will be used to identify areas of concern (i.e... health concerns, disabilities or impairments requiring accommodation, etc.) or special attention. This screening will include at least the following:
 - Interview by an authorized parish, school, or agency representative or staff person.
 - Completion of a written application process that includes a request for information re: name, address, phone, any area of concern and any experience that would make this person suitable for the position being filled.
 - Confirmation by the Office of Child, Youth, and Adult Protection that the adult has attended the Safe Environment Workshop and successfully completed a criminal background check.
3. ALL adult leaders and participants who are of LEGAL DRINKING AGE (21 years old) are expected to be leaders and examples to younger attendees; therefore, all adult leaders & and participants must REFRAIN FROM DRINKING. The purchase, possession, or consumption of beer, wine, or other alcoholic beverages by minors will not be tolerated. Adults who allow or encourage such activity are in violation of the law and appropriate action will be taken.
4. The possession or use of ILLEGAL DRUGS by any individual will not be tolerated. An infraction of this rule will mean an immediate dismissal from any event and appropriate action will be taken.
5. For the protection and safety of all participants, acts of violence or harassment will not be tolerated. Leaders and chaperones must be alert to and prepared to stop all acts of violence and harassment.
6. All adults must comply with the Diocesan Safe Environment guidelines and the Guidelines Concerning the Supervision of Minors. Both of these documents are available from the Child, Youth, and Adult Protection office. (208) 342-1311.
7. Disruptive behavior, language, clothing, or items will not be acceptable at youth events. This includes any of the above which is obscene, profane, or inappropriate to the activity of the church or group.
8. Adults may not enter gambling halls, casinos, or other establishments where organized gambling takes place. As a chaperone, you are not to go anywhere where the youth who look to you for leadership can not accompany you. It is illegal for minors to take part in any organized form of gambling, and therefore such activity is strictly prohibited. Any other gambling activity should also be discouraged.
9. The use of tobacco in any form on parish/Diocesan transportation is not permitted. Also, due to the documented health risks from secondhand smoke, smoking is prohibited in all assembly areas and shared sleeping quarters.
10. All activities sponsored by a parish, school, agency, or organization affiliated with the Diocese of Boise must be planned and organized in order to assure the safety and well-being of the participants who will be taking part in them. All reasonable precautions must be taken to ensure that these events are safe and appropriately chaperoned. (Example: If you take your group swimming, a certified lifeguard must be in attendance.)
11. Adults who are asked to transport youth to or from organized events and who are solicited for this activity by a Diocesan organization, parish, school, or agency must adhere to all the requirements listed in the Transportation Policy of the Diocese of Boise.
12. Adults in leadership positions are expected to help enforce the code of behavior as it pertains to youth and to set an example for them.

SOME NOTES... The Diocese does not insure personal property against theft or loss so please exercise caution regarding your own personal property. You are expected to observe the above guidelines in light of Idaho State statutes and definitions, even when taking part in events that may take place in another state or country. (EXAMPLE: The legal drinking age in Idaho state is 21. This age will be the norm followed, even when in a place where the legal drinking age is lower.) The major thing to remember is that you represent the Church and are asked to demonstrate Christian consideration, sensitivity, and respect to others and to the property around you.
